

PROGRAMS

- ✓ **Twos, Threes & K-Ready (4-5-year-olds)**, meet Mondays to Fridays, offering a flexible schedule and extended-day activities, as well as before and after care hours.
- ✓ **Early Twos**, for children who turn 2 by March 31, flexible schedule.
- ✓ **Tot Time**, for parents/caregivers and their children ages 12 to 23 months, meets on Tuesdays from 9:30 to 11:00 AM.
- ✓ **Busy Babies**, a free program for babies 3-11 months with an adult, on Mondays, from 11:00 AM to noon, featuring live music by *Song for Seeds*, (on selected dates) stories & socializing.
- ✓ **The Early School Camp**, a great place for children ages 2 to 5 to be for 7 weeks in the summer, Monday to Friday. Tot Time Camp, a program for parents with toddlers ages 12 to 23 months, meets Tuesdays in July and August.

- Providing an atmosphere that encourages children to be productive and creative.
- Developing fine and gross motor skills.
- Providing a strong foundation for reading, writing, math and science.
