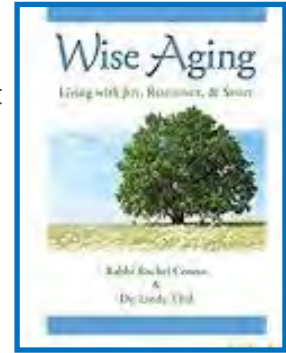
Wise Aging, a book by Rachel Cowan and Dr. Linda Thal, addresses how we might make this time one of growth and enrichment rather than decline.
